It was our honour to invite Sr Yu Kam Hung, the Past President of the HKIS, to share with us his views on the topic, "Effectiveness of the series of anti-speculative measures on the property market" on 1 November 2013. During the session, Sr Yu analyzed the phenomenon of Hong Kong's property market, the introduction of anti-speculative measures (including a stamp duty for property sales, increasing the supply of residential properties, and enhancing land supply) that serve as indicators of the impact of governmental policies on the property market, and the effectiveness of these measures.
