

Membership of Multiple Divisions

Each Fellow or Member who becomes a member of more than one Division shall be entitled to vote in each Division, but shall be eligible to represent, or hold office in only one Division at any one time. Members of more than one Division would be able to use alternative designations concurrently.

An application to join an additional Division should be based upon an appropriate level of work experience in the field of the receiving Division. The Board of Membership interprets an appropriate level as the equivalent of 50% of two years relevant full-time experience in the additional division for the two years preceding the date of the application. This experience must be since qualification as a Corporate Member of our Institute. The procedure for members wishing to apply will be completion of an application which must be supported by Four Fellows and at least two of them are members of the “receiving” division(s), one of whom should submit a Letter of Recommendation.

Applications to hold Multiple Membership are assessed in the context of the quality and relevance of the CPD that has been achieved. The ability to demonstrate why a member should be entitled to hold membership of more than one division of surveying without taking an additional Final Assessment will be carefully scrutinized in terms of personal, professional and technical development. Applications are therefore to be accompanied by a photocopy of the members’ CPD Record showing not less than 20 hours CPD in your current division together with not less than 20 hours CPD in the additional division.

All applicants must demonstrate that in the three years immediately prior to the application they have fulfilled the requirements of the CPD regulations of 60 hours activity.
