NOTES TO APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

I. QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP (Bye-Law 2.3)

The following Bye-Laws relate to the class of Members:-

Bye Law 2.3.4

Those persons who are at least 21 years of age who are corporate members of such professional bodies as the General Council may recognize from time to time as being of equal status, and who have been engaged in the profession in Hong Kong for a minimum of one year since attaining corporate membership of the recognized professional body as aforesaid may be admitted as Members. The General Council may, at its discretion, substitute the aforesaid requirement of local experience by a requirement of local knowledge, and require the candidate to submit to a professional interview administered by the Board of Membership.

Bye-Law 2.3.5

Those persons who are at least 21 years of age and ----

- (a) have obtained either
 - (i) a cognate graduate degree or equivalent as may be approved by the General Council from time to time as being of sufficient academic standard for entry to the profession; or
 - (ii) a non-cognate but good graduate degree or equivalent as may be approved by the General Council from time to time as being of sufficient academic standard for entry to the profession and have after obtaining such degree been engaged in surveying practices for not less than five years; or
 - (iii) technical membership of the Institute and have after obtaining such membership been engaged in surveying practices for not less than five years; and
 - (b) have undertaken a minimum of two years professional training of an approved nature in Hong Kong, or mainly in Hong Kong; and
 - (c) have undergone an Assessment of Professional Competence as may be determined by the Board of Education from time to time, which will also provide for a professional interview administered by the Board of Education,
- may be admitted as Members.

Bye-Law 2.8.2

In case an application for admission as a Member is rejected, the Board of Membership shall not be required to give any reason for the rejection. Any such applicant not admitted may not again submit an application for admission as a Member until 12 calendar months shall have elapsed from the date the application was rejected.

II GENERAL

1. The application should be completed in full and must be accompanied by the following documents as appropriate:-
 - (i) photocopy of Certificates of membership of other professional institutions (Bye-Law 2.3.4);
 - (ii) photocopy of Certificates relating to academic qualifications;
 - (iii) photocopy of letter confirming a pass in the Assessment of Professional Competence;
 - (iv) photocopy of applicant's Hong Kong identity card.
2. All photocopies of the above accompanying documentation (i-iv) MUST be Certified True Copy by a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors.
3. Applications received which do not meet the full requirements of the Bye-Laws of the Institute, as referred to above, will not be considered.
4. If Certified True Copies of membership of any other relevant professional institution are not available, and the Institute is required to seek independent confirmation of such membership, a search fee of \$500 is levied.
5. False declarations, whether on the part of the applicant or the proposers, may lead to disciplinary and/or legal action.
6. Applications for membership will be considered by the Board of Membership at its next meeting scheduled for that purpose, provided that the application has been received at least 5 weeks in advance of that meeting. The applicant may be required to attend that meeting and one of the proposers may be asked also to attend to introduce the applicant to members of the Board of Membership (see Part IV - Nomination).
7. Any person applying for admission into membership shall pay an application fee which shall be non-refundable whether or not such person is admitted into membership.
8. Any member shall be liable to pay the annual subscription for the ensuing year upon admission into membership and upon expiry of the annual subscription for the current year. (Financial year runs from 1st April to 31st March).
9. Application Fee and Annual Subscription are payable upon application. Please issue a cheque payable to "The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors", and attach it to the application form.

***** Under the Memorandum of Mutual Recognition of Membership made between the HKIS and the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS), corporate members of RICS (FRICS and MRICS) qualified in the former Divisions whose principal place of practice being in Hong Kong may upon application to HKIS be admitted to the corresponding grades of membership of HKIS in the corresponding Divisions. Corporate members of RICS (MRICS) admitted to membership of RICS in the exant Faculties whose principal place of practice in Hong Kong may upon application to HKIS be admitted to membership of HKIS (MHKIS) in the relevant Divisions subject to 1 year's post qualification professional experience in Hong Kong relevant to a Division of HKIS and a professional interview.

**By Reciprocity Agreement between the HKIS and the Singapore Institute of Surveyors and Valuers (SISV), a corporate member of the SISV who has one year's experience in Hong Kong, upon application, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS.

**By Reciprocity Agreement between the HKIS and the Australian Property Institute (API), an Associate or Fellow member of the API who has one year's experience in Hong Kong, upon application, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS General Practice Division.

**By Reciprocity Agreement between the HKIS and the New Zealand Property Institute (NZPI), a Member of the NZPI who has one year's experience in Hong Kong, upon application, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS General Practice Division.

**By Reciprocity Agreement between the HKIS and the Australian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (AIQS), a corporate member of the AIQS who has one year's experience in Hong Kong, upon application, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS Quantity Surveying Division.

**By Reciprocity Agreement between the HKIS and the New Zealand Institute of Quantity Surveyors Incorporated (NZIQS), an Associate, Member, Fellow or Life Member of the NZIQS who has one year's experience in Hong Kong, upon application, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS Quantity Surveying Division.
