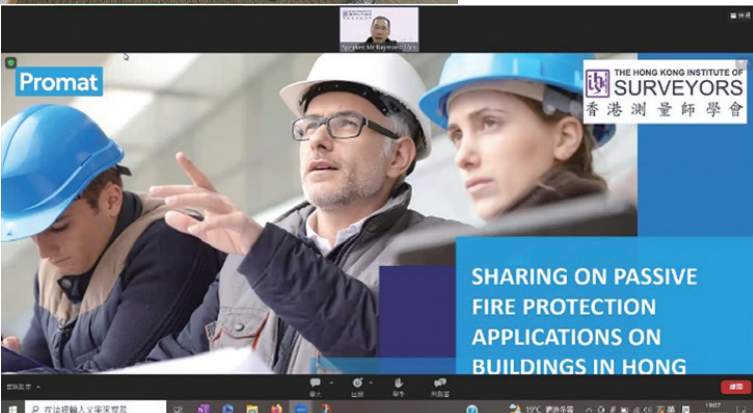
CPD Event: “Sharing Session on Passive Fire Protection Applications for Buildings in Hong Kong”

A CPD, “Sharing Session on Passive Fire Protection Applications for Buildings in Hong Kong,” was successfully held on 30 January with around 120 young members in attendance.

Guest speaker Mr Raymond Man began by introducing the current requirements for fire-resistant construction under the Code of Practice for Fire Safety in Buildings 2012. He also explained the testing methods and standards that the Buildings Department accepted. In addition to the statutory requirements, Raymond

highlighted a multitude of general products for passive fire protection systems including fire-resistant boards and fire stops supplemented by real-life applications of these systems in several projects.
