"Create Your District" Competition 2023 Competition Workshop & Guided Tour

Over 100 Students and Surveyors Explored the Northern Metropolis

The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) held the "Create Your District" Competition 2023
Competition Workshop and Guided Tour on 8 July 2023 (Saturday). Mr LAU Kwok-fan, MH, JP,
Legco Member (New Territories North) and Chairman of Subcommittee on Matters Relating
to the Development of the Northern Metropolis, Sr Paul WONG Kwok-leung, President of the
HKIS and Sr Francis LAM Ka-fai, Senior Vice-President of the HKIS and Chairman of the
Competition Organising Committee attended the Competition Workshop to share their views on
planning the Northern Metropolis with participating students and highlighted the important role that
surveyors play in urban planning. Later, the three joined the Guided Tour with participating
students, and visited various places in the Northern Metropolis, including the historically significant
Tang Ancestral Hall, Kwu Tung North New Development Area which is still in the planning and
construction stage, and Lok Ma Chau Garden which overlook San Tin/Lok Ma Chau and the Loop.
The Tour provides a multidimensional introduction to the economic and social status, geographic,
land, and ecological resource advantages of the region.

In his welcoming speech, **Sr Paul WONG Kwok-leung** said, "Young people have boundless imagination. However, to make the planning blueprint in their minds more feasible, they must equip with more professional knowledge and gain a deeper understanding of the region." He hopes that the Competition Workshop and Guided Tour can deepen students' understanding of the history, cultural traditions, and urban development of the Northern Metropolis, and provide a deeper understanding of issues such as urban planning, land development, property valuation, construction and management, and sustainable development.



**Sr Francis LAM Ka-fai** stated, "All of you present here today are the future leaders of our society. If we want the future Northern Metropolis to meet the increasingly diverse needs of the younger generation, you must be brave enough to express your own ideas." He also pointed out that students are the new force driving social development, "I am very much looking forward to you becoming professional surveyors in the near future and turning the planning blueprint you envisioned in this competition into a reality, building a Northern Metropolis that can meet the various life and work needs of the younger generation."

This is the fifth year that the HKIS has organised the creativity competition, with the theme area being the Northern Metropolis which is the new foothold for Hong Kong's strategic development in the future. The event aims to deepen the understanding of the history, cultural traditions, and urban development of the region among young people who will be future leaders, and to encourage them to unleash their creativity to build an ideal community that combines emerging economies, cultural leisure, quality living, and green conservation, thereby promoting the sustainability and innovation of urban development. The HKIS hopes to promote the surveying industry to the younger generation through the competition, thereby promoting the development of the industry.
