## **The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors Annual General Meeting 2018 Inauguration of the New General Council**

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) was held on 13 December 2018. Sr Dr Tony LEUNG was elected as President of the HKIS for 2018 – 2019. The retired President Sr Dick KWOK will carry his title as Immediate Past President to continue devoting his time to the Institute.

At the AGM, Sr Winnie SHIU was elected as Senior Vice-President, and Sr Edwin TANG and Sr CHIU Kam Kuen were both elected as Vice-President, while Sr Paul WONG and Sr Alexander LAM were elected as Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Secretary respectively.

The incoming President, Sr Dr Tony LEUNG, is a Fellow Member of the HKIS. He served as Chairman of the HKIS's Planning & Development Division between 2013 and 2015. #### **About the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors**

Established in 1984, The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) is the only surveying professional body incorporated by ordinance in Hong Kong. As of 19 October 2018, the number of members reached 10,217, of which 6,782 were corporate members, 77 were associate members and 3358 were probationers and students. HKIS work includes setting standards for professional services and performance, establishing codes of ethics, determining requirements for admission as professional surveyors, and encouraging members to upgrade skills through continuing professional development.

HKIS has an important consultative role in government policy making and on issues affecting the profession. We have advised the government on issues such as unauthorized building works, building safety campaign, problems of property management, town planning and development strategies, construction quality and housing problems. We are working on amendments to standard forms of building contract and have issued guidance notes on floor area measurement methods.
