




# *Reciprocity Agreement*

**SINGAPORE INSTITUTE OF SURVEYORS AND VALUERS  
&  
THE HONG KONG INSTITUTE OF SURVEYORS**


Whereas the Singapore Institute of Surveyors and Valuers (SISV) and The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) see benefits to members of both professional bodies in setting up a Reciprocity Agreement, SISV and the HKIS agree the following:

- 1 A corporate member (Member or Fellow) of SISV in good standing, may be elected as a Member of the HKIS subject to:
  - a one year's practice in Hong Kong in circumstances which will enable a corporate member of HKIS to confirm the professional activities undertaken. During the period applicants will be required to maintain a detailed record of their experience, followed by:
  - b a professional interview conducted by the HKIS to test the applicant's knowledge of law and practice in Hong Kong;
  - c subsequent election to fellowship being subject to the Bye-laws and Regulations of HKIS.
  
- 2 A corporate member (Member or Fellow) of the HKIS in good standing, may be elected as a Member of SISV subject to:
  - a one year's practice in Singapore in circumstances which will enable a corporate member of SISV to confirm the professional activities undertaken. During the period applicants will be required to maintain a detailed record of their experience, followed by:
  - b a professional interview conducted by SISV to test the applicant's knowledge of law and practice in Singapore;
  - c subsequent election to fellowship being subject to the Bye-laws and Regulations of SISV.
  
- 3 Applicants will join the relevant Division. The agreement includes Building Surveyors, Land Surveyors, Quantity Surveyors and Valuation and General Practice Surveyors.
  
- 4 This agreement does not apply to any member of SISV or HKIS who has been elected to membership of either body through a reciprocity agreement with other professional bodies.
  
- 5 Each professional body will notify the other of any proposed merger or major constitutional change.
